## Things You Can Do With An E-Card

### Download Books and Magazines

We have thousands of books, audiobooks and magazines you can download to your phone, tablet or computer. All you need is an Internet connection.



### Use Library Computers and Printers

We have approximately 70 computers at the Library. You can use one of them for up to three hours per day. You may also print for a small fee.



### Download Free Music

You can download up to five songs per week that are yours to keep. All you need is an Internet connection.



### Learn Online

You can work on almost any skill through one of our website links. For example:

- Learn computer programming, graphic design, digital photography and business skills with Lynda.com.
- Take practice tests, prep for the GED or write a resume with Learning Express.
- Learn one of 80 languages with Pronunciator.
- Beef up your computer skills with online courses on popular programs such as Microsoft Office, Adobe InDesign, coding with Java and HTML, and more.
- Watch online videos to build up important career skills such as communication and critical thinking.



## Here's How You Do It

- 1 Visit our website at [fpl.info/ecards](http://fpl.info/ecards) to complete the online application form. (See notes below for qualifying zip codes.)
- 2 Once you submit your application, check your email for your E-card information. You will receive an E-card number and a password. You will need this information to set up accounts for downloading, and also for using computers in the Library. Please keep this information in a safe place.

Now you're ready to start using digital Library resources! If you need help setting up your devices to download, please refer to the instructions on our website, or call the Library at 810.249.2569 to schedule a free, 30-minute lesson through our "Book an Expert" service.

## Important Notes

- You will need a valid email address to which we can send your E-card number.
- We do not send you a physical card. Your E-card number and password are your E-card.
- E-cards are available for residents in the 48501-48507 zip codes, as well as 48532. (Michigan residents living in other zip codes are welcome to stop by the Library and get a full-service card.)
- You may use any of our digital or downloadable resources with your E-card. If you would like to check materials out of the Library, please visit the Checkout Desk with your photo ID so that we can issue you a new, full-service card.
- You will receive an email once each year with instructions on how to renew your E-card.
